## Diagnostic centre construction begins

Building work has started on a Community Diagnostic Centre at the University of Bedfordshire.

In partnership with Bedfordshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, the facility will provide endoscopy services, CT scanning and bone density (DEXA) scanning.

The CDC will support earlier diagnosis, reduce travel and waiting times, and create valuable placement and learning opportunities for students.



## Police on patrol

Luton Town Centre Community Policing Team carried out a day of proactive patrols as part of Op Foresight, aimed at disrupting criminality and reassuring the public.

Officers made multiple arrests and issued community protection warning notices. Highly visible patrols continue!

## Nighttime Economy boost

The Council's Executive has approved 15 recommendations made by the Task and Finish Group, set up to look at ways of improving our town centre nightlife.

Some of the ideas to be explored are:

- better lighting and safety measures
- pedestrianisation of key areas
- free parking

This is a step in the right direction as we work to improve Luton's nighttime offer.
